After completing my A-Levels and leaving Trinity in 2021, I went on to study history at Exeter, where I soon became involved in the student newspaper Exeposé! This encouraged me to channel a lifelong passion for journalism and media into a (semi-) professional outlet, and I rose to become the newspaper's Deputy Editor in my final year. Drawing on this student media experience, as well as work experience with local newspaper Newbury Weekly News, I obtained a place on the competitive BBC News journalist apprenticeship, considered the best journalism apprenticeship scheme in the country, after five rounds of interviews and assessments. As of September 2024, I now work at the iconic BBC Broadcasting House in London alongside the team on the BBC News Channel, producing and researching the stories that have made the BBC the most successful and famous news outlet in the world, whilst also studying for a Level 7 qualification in journalism.
